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HENRIETTA PUBLIC LIBRARY

PROJECT SUMMARY

The Town of Henrietta selected Christa Construction LLC as the Construction Manager of the new public library. The two-story, 36,000 square foot library is on 2.8 acres of land.

A main priority for the project is making the facility accessible to the entire community. These improvements include sliding entry doors, adequate space for walkways and full size elevator. An additional feature for accessibility are audio systems equipped with hearing loops. This feature will allow library guests the option to have sound transmitted directly to their hearing aids or cochlear implants.

The library incorporates green initiatives, including a geothermal HVAC system and LED lighting. The Town collaborated with RIT students to bring a unique design element to the facility, creating an oak tree sculpture. The sculpture is made from repurposed wood that stood at the former campus's main entrance. This project has been awarded the Gold Award in the ACEC New York 2020 Engineering Excellence Awards and the Best Educational/Institutional project at the 2020 NAIOP Awards.

CHILI COMMUNITY CENTER

The New Chili Community Center is a 95,000 square foot new build. This community center will house a new library, senior center and recreation center with private fitness rooms and walking track on the second floor surrounding the gymnasium. With the partnership of Passero Associates, this \$20.0 million project will be a community hub for years to come for the Rochester community. The Project Team is planning for completion of Spring 2021.

TOWN OF GREECE LIBRARY EXPANSION

CHILI FIRE DEPARTMENT (IN PROGRESS)

New construction of a 18,000 square foot fire department will include a new dispatch area, apparatus bays, training room, meeting room and bunk room.

The existing fire department has seen multiple alterations but as the facility reaches its 36th birthday, ever-changing needs of the community with logistical challenges with running a modern fire fighting force required a new approach.

The new facility will provide a mix of private and public spaces dedicated to a host of services. The new fire department is also designed to meet future needs and functional spaces for the fire fighters who serve the Chili community.

The project consists of two components - a new 10,500 SF fire station and the renovation of the adjacent existing training center facility as well as site work. The new building includes living quarters, office space, locker rooms, fitness room, a day room, advanced personal equipment storage as well as a drive through apparatus bay. The existing building will include new seats, updated lighting and HVAC equipment and a new roofing membrane.

The north addition consisted of the following: association meeting room, lunch/break room, commissioners meeting room, fire department business office, line officers room, chief's office, paid staff office & lieutenant's office.

The south addition consisted of the following: two large apparatus bays for fire trucks, training room, exercise/fitness room, outside equipment storage room, washer & hose room, explorer's room, and toilet rooms.

Interior renovations included relocation of the Bunk Room, renovation of the toilet rooms including new locker rooms and showers in both facilities, as well as renovations of the radio room, dining hall, and existing apparatus bays and equipment room

HENRIETTA RECREATION CENTER

PROJECT SUMMARY

The Henrietta Recreation Center is a 2-story, 41,000 square foot steel structure, with a combination brick veneer and metal panel exterior. The facility is located adjacent to the Henrietta Town Hall on Calkins Road on the re-developing Henrietta Municipal Campus.

The Recreation Center opened in Fall 2016 and includes a gymnasium (featuring basketball, volleyball and pickleball courts) an elevated indoor walking track, activity rooms, multipurpose meeting room, dedicated gymnastics area, batting cage and a preschool activity room.

This facility was the first step towards re-vitalizing the town's municipal campus and centralizing all services to one location.

IRONDEQUOIT DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS GARAGE

PROJECT SUMMARY

New construction of a 72,000 square foot Department of Public Works Garage on 10.9 acres of land will eventually house a 70 member staff, 100 vehicles and include energy efficient solar panels. The garage is estimated to be twice as large as the previous garage that was destroyed by fire in December 2016. To fully serve the Irondequoit community, the DPW maintains a large fleet, resulting in a unique double-bay pull-through garage to keep as much of their heavy vehicle equipment indoors. This project was recently awarded the American Public Works Association Project of the Year in the category of Structures Projects - \$5-\$25 Million.
